BOYS/GIRLS Basketball Program 2021

- Any freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior presently attending school is eligible to participate.

You MUST be attending school in order to participate – no out of school suspensions.

- You cannot participate if you are playing on your school team as it violates KHSAA rules.
- There may be up to four divisions based in part on the ages of players on the team.
- Teams will be placed in a league based on the highest grade of any one player per team.
- Teams may be co-ed but there is no co-ed requirement.
- Each team must designate a team captain or coach, who will be the contact person for PAL administrative matters.
- There will be a maximum limit of ten (10) players per team and no more than two players may be added to any team after the first week's game.
- A player can only play for one PAL team per season.
- Games will be played each Saturday beginning February 13th.
- There will be five regular weekly games followed by a championship tournament.
- There are a limited number of teams available and they will be entered into the league on a first-come, first-serve basis, determined by the date and time you turned in your application and fee.
- In order to maintain distance and prevent spread of the virus, only one spectator per player is allowed at games, all participants and spectators must wear masks when entering and exiting from games, masks are not required while playing or where distancing can be provided.

Temperature checks may be required for all players and spectators.

The fee for this league is \$415.00 per team, paid by check or money orders made payable to PAL or Police Athletic League. Remember to get your application and fee in early.

The DEADLINE is January 29th, 2021, at 4:00pm.

Please do not wait until the deadline, as most leagues fill up several days before the deadline.
