Summer Soccer Camps

Camp Director, Chris Jones

Chris Jones' was named the Washburn Ichabod soccer head coach on July 10, 2015 becoming the second coach in the program's history after spending the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at Fort Hays State.

While earning his Master's of Science in Health and Human Performance from Fort Hays State (2015), Jones helped guide the Tigers to a record of 20-13-5 over two years, including the team's highest-ever finish in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association standings in 2014.

Prior to Fort Hays he served as the head coach and president of the University of Oklahoma Men's Soccer Club from 2010-12

He has a wide range of experience, including spending time as a practice player for the Oklahoma women's team, which featured the Big 12 Offensive Player of the Year. Jones also spent the 2014 season as the head coach of Thomas More Prep-Marian leading the Monarchs to the regional championship game. He graduated from Oklahoma in the spring of 2013 with a degree in Sociology after transferring from Northeastern State University, where he was a goalkeeper for the men's team from 2007-2009.

 - Registration form is not signed by parent or guardian
 - Incorrect fees are sent
 - Birth Certificate for first time player is not included
- ☛ If you would like to pay with a credit card, on-line registration is available at www.sunflowersoccer.org (credit card service fee of 2.49% + \$1.00)
- ☛ Program available to youth who are no younger than 3 and no older than 13 on 8-1-16. 8th graders who are 14 years old are eligible to play.
- ☛ A photocopy of a state certified birth certificate must be included for all first time players. (hospital birth announcements are not acceptable)

- ☛ Due to roster limitations, we cannot guarantee placement for all those who submit a registration form. If we are unable to place a player we will issue a full refund.
- ☛ Registrations received after the final registration deadline will be placed in a pool and assigned on a first come/first serve basis. This includes returning players.

General Information:

- ☛ The fall season begins mid to late August and is complete by mid October.
- ☛ The spring season begins in early March and is complete by late April.
- ☛ A coach will contact players with practice information approximately 2 weeks before the season starts.
- ☛ Game schedules will be posted on our website www.sunflowersoccer.org.
- ☛ **Players receive a new uniform each FALL.** If a child does not play in the FALL they will receive a uniform in the SPRING. If a player is assigned to a different team in the SPRING a new uniform will be provided. The cost is included in the registration fee. The U4-U6 players receive a uniform shirt; The U7 and above players receive a full uniform consisting of a shirt, shorts & socks.
- ☛ The uniform that is received in the fall will also be worn during the spring season unless the player is assigned to a different team. Please take this into consideration when choosing the size. The fee to replace a uniform shirt that is lost, damaged or outgrown is \$15 for U4-U6 players and \$20 for U7-U14 players. **PLEASE KEEP THE UNIFORM YOUR CHILD RECEIVES IN THE FALL IF HE/SHE IS PLANNING TO PLAY IN THE SPRING!**
- ☛ All players are required to wear shin guards and socks that cover them.
- ☛ You may NOT request a coach for your child. Teams are formed based on where the child attends school and home address location. You may request to play with a friend, but we cannot guarantee that placement.

Refund Policy: To receive a refund, please submit a written request (email is acceptable) to our office, prior to the first Saturday of scheduled league games. An administrative fee of \$15 will be assessed to the refund. No refunds will be given after the season starts.
