## What we have been learning!

**Language Arts:** We are diving into our English and Language Arts curriculum! This program emphasizes vocabulary, grammar, phonics, spelling, reading and writing. Our focus has been on short vowel words. We enjoyed our first story in our hard-back readers. Your child will bring home their reader each Thursday to share a story with you. We have been practicing writing sentences with a naming and telling part that include capitalization, spacing, and periods.

**Science/Social Studies-** The year began with a study of Rules and Laws. We are now studying Solar Energy and the Seasons. Our Solar S'mores will be a great way to kick-off this study.

**Math-** We have started our math series Go Math! Students have been learning how to add using counters, linking cubes, and pictures. We have also learned new vocabulary such as: addends, sum, and equals to. Next, we will begin to learn about subtraction.

Working through homework pages with your child is a great way to guide your student for math success!

**Invitation Reminder:** Please remember students may only hand out birthday invitations at school if they are inviting every student in their classroom. This way we can avoid hurt feelings. Thanks for your help!
