Spotlight on Literacy

This school year, our staff will be placing a special emphasis on reading this year. One way to promote literacy with your child is by helping your child develop expressive language skills and by limiting your child's screen time.



The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends the following regarding screen time for your child:

- For children ages 2 to 5 years, limit screen use to 1 hour per day of high-quality programs. Parents should co-view media with children to help them understand what they are seeing and apply it to the world around them.
- For children ages 6 and older, place consistent limits on the time spent using media, and the types of media, and make sure media does not take the place of adequate sleep, physical activity and other behaviors essential to health

Counselor's Corner

Hi, I'm Christie Wartman the counselor at PC! In this section, you will find some ways we as a school are helping foster social and emotional growth within our students. Teachers in every classroom teach Second Step, a social emotional curriculum, for 20 minutes a day. Each grade level is working on a unit called "Skills for Learning". Kindergarten is working on how to learn to listen and focus attention. First grade is working on listening to learn and focusing attention. Second grade is working on being respectful learners, focusing attention and listening. Third grade is working on being respectful learners and using self-talk. In addition to Second Step, I also teach each grade level a character trait each month that is reinforced in the classroom.
