

**PC/PS PTO Minutes**  
**February 2, 2017**

1. **Call to order** (Gary Knoles, President)
2. **Principals' Reports** –
  - Mr. Hageman – PC – averaged between 40-50 students absent the last couple weeks (about 10%, typically at 5% per day); Boys & Girls Club officially takes over Velma K. Paris on February 13 with before and after school, will also have School Day Out, and will begin looking at summer programming – grant from Advisor's Excel for the program (\$100,000 over the next five years); beginning to interview for positions (Carlin Smith moving to kindergarten, Mallory Scott from Williams coming into 1<sup>st</sup> grade position); Roadrunners Night – about 56 tickets from PC
  - Mr. Holman – PS – Parent-Teacher Conferences are in two weeks, if you do not know your time, please contact the school; BINGO Night was a success, thank you PTO for the \$400 donation, it was a nice event with about 90 participants; Roadrunner Hockey Night went well; 15 new students since January 5<sup>th</sup>, great to welcome new families to our community; 367 enrolled now

  - Jen Mercer requested a program "Hands On Equations" – highly successful program in her experience (\$245/set; \$1225 for entire 6<sup>th</sup> grade)

  - Request made by principals for 50" monitors for each school
    - Approximately \$3000 (by the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year)
    - Principals will bring proposal to next meeting

  - Shared school supplies pack examples (EPI does both spirit wear and supplies), 24/school minimum, concern that EPI could supply very specific items (not substitutes)
