2. Principals' Reports

- All product has been picked up. Limo rides were a success. Limo cost was an extra \$40 over budget: \$20 for larger limo to accommodate group and \$20 for driver gratuity. Frozen food sold very well. Next year, plan for more freezer space to store and coordinate with food service staff, as they had just placed a large order, so limited freezer space was available. Orders should arrive on Tuesday, not Wednesday. Profit of \$7,759.50. Increase of approx. \$4,700 over last year.
