Housing Assistance

- **Equity Access Shelter** 785-368-9533
 - Individuals who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless no longer need to contact multiple agencies to receive rent/mortgage assistance. E.A.S. staff will work with individuals to assess level of need and connect individuals with the right resources. There is a wait list.
- **East Central Kansas Economic Opportunity Corporation** 785-242-7450
 - Energy-efficient assistance to improve heating and cooling and energy savings. Eligibility is based on household income relative to federal income guidelines.

 - Modifications to residential homes for individuals with physical disabilities. Emergency repairs to help homeowners with immediate health or safety problems. Weatherization assistance to help eligible homeowners make upgrades to their homes.

Adult Education

 - Adult basic education and GED prep classes including math, reading, writing, science, social studies, and computers. Classes start every 8 weeks. There is a \$30 sign-up fee.
- **Washburn Tech Advantage Center** 785-670-2248
 - Adult education classes, GED prep, and English as a Second Language classes. Orientations are scheduled 5-6 times per year. Classes Monday through Friday for 3 hours either in the morning or afternoon for 6 weeks. Evening classes also available. There is a \$30 sign-up fee.

 - Help for adults wishing to complete their high school diploma. Classes typically begin in August, November, January, and April. Enrollment is free for students over the age of 18 whose class has already graduated.

 - Career Readiness Training for residents. It is a 12 weeks employment program to enhance life management and job skills for long-term employment.
