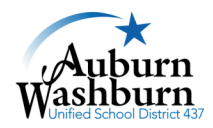

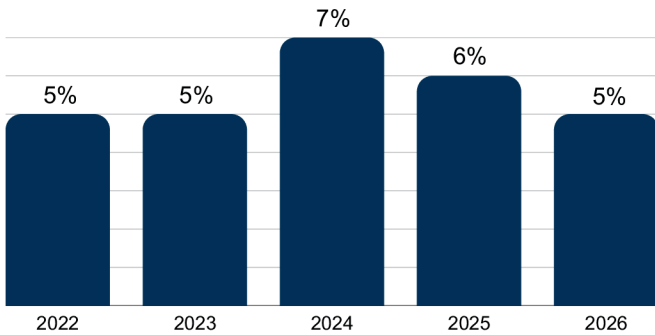

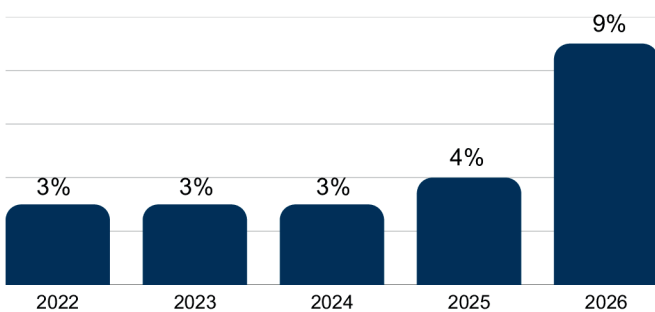

- + Adopted and implemented character development curriculum for grades Pre K-8

TECHNOLOGY AND FINANCIAL LITERACY



- + Embedded technology-rich instruction at every level
