Washburn Rural Reunion Minutes

May 4th, 2019

The Washburn Rural All-Years Reunion was held Saturday, May 4th, 2019 in the school cafeteria. Ginger Powell, President, welcomed the group and introduced the head table. The invocation was by 1969 Jubilee classmate Rick Howbert. The flag salute was followed by the dinner buffet.

President Powell introduced Principal Ed Raines who shared the graduation rate for Washburn Rural was 94.5. The enrollment total for students was 1959 and Rural employed 235 people in the building which is open from 5am to 1:30am.

President Powell acknowledged classes in the 40's, 50's, 60's, 70's, 80's, 90's and even a few alumni from 2000's. It was noted that the classes in the 70's and 80's needed to beef up their attendance totals. A request for donations for the Alumni Association was made by President Powell, reminding those present that there are no dues for the WRHS Alumni Association. Donations are the total source of funding for the alumni group and this reunion.

The Golden Jubilee class of 1969 was introduced and Principal Raines presented each with WRHS medallions. Each member of the 50th year class shared a few words.

From Indiana we heard from two former Rural students. Class of 1937's Lois Sherman Miller and class of 1938's Marion Miller who are in their 77th year of marriage. They send greetings to all! From Texas we received a message from Jack Duff, class of 1942. He said age and distance are causing him to miss another reunion. It didn't seem possible that 76 years had gone by since graduation, WWII in the Navy and an air traffic controller career. Jack said he believes he and Dick Sheets are the only ones left of the 26 graduates of the class of 1942. He said good luck to all and he hoped we would have a happy reunion. From Arizona the 1947 class president, Bob Jepson sent greetings to his classmates! He said he could not be there as his traveling days are over. Best regards to all Rural alumni.
