The cast and crew of Urinetown, the Musical invite you to a side-splitting sendup of greed, love, revolution (and musicals!), in a time when water is worth its weight in gold.

In a Gotham-like city, a terrible water shortage, caused by a 20-year drought, has led a government-enforced ban on private toilets. The citizens must use public amenities, regulated

by a single malevolent company that profits by charging admission for one of humanity's most basic needs. Amid the people, a hero decides that he's had enough and plans a revolution to lead them all to freedom.

Winner of three Tony Awards, three Outer Circle Awards, two Lucille Lortel Awards and two Obie Awards, and inspired by the works of Bertolt Brecht and Kurt Weill.
