Treasurer's Report	Janelle Martin will be the PTO Treasurer for the 2025-26 school year. Bethany C gave the Treasurer's Report. PTO's current balance is \$18,220.11. The proposed budget for the upcoming year is \$17,000. It was a suggested proposal to increase the Teacher Requests budget by \$500 per

school, as well as a \$500 increase per school for funds allotted for Hospitality/Staff Appreciation. More information on Book Break funds requested by Teresa Riner (PC Librari) will be provided at the September meeting.
